



























t - The Grand Chandeliers

Invented during the medieval period, they were originally used as strong sources of light candles till the 18th century. When gas lights were invented, it replaced the use of candles. Eventually electric lights superseded them in the latter half of the 20th century and the beginning of the 21st century.

Given its vibrant history, The Oberoi Grand at Kolkata, boasts of a number of elaborately ornate and antique chandeliers housed throughout the property. Though heterogeneous in style, they beautifully compliment the neo-classical décor, bringing out the flavour of the hotel's colonial roots and its entrenchment in affluent Indian landscape.





Lobby Chandelier

Procured from the forested 'Bohemian Netherlands' perchedon the Lusatian Mountains in Northern Bohemia, the enchanting piece bears the characteristic marks of the High Baroque Bohemian chandelier with a subtle English flavour. The design is dynamically form-decorative, abstract, and emotional.

Divided into 4 tiers, the 'bowl' chandelier is two-colour-cased and comprises 48 chimney glasses of hand-blown and hand-cut iridescent low-lead, potash glass. The chimney glasses are heavy-bottomed with tulip-like 'champagne flutes'.



The Ballroom Chandeliers

The Ballroom at The Oberoi Grand is a royal affair, thanks to the five elegant six-tiered chandeliers gracing it.

Each chandelier is a crystal chandelier, circular in shape, with six arms attached to protruding lights. The prisms hanging from the circular tiers are elongated and plaque-shaped giving the chandeliers' appearances of the 'Bohemian' tassels-laden dream-catcher; these have facets and bevels on both sides. The chandeliers are placed along a meridian running between the circular bas-relief features on the ceiling of the Ballroom.

The Candle Chandeliers

The respective Burdawan and Coochbehar banquet halls are graced with candle chandeliers that take the decoration back to the roots.

Employing a rustic and art-deco flavour, these brass chandeliers have simple arms which are topped with candle-shaped lights and minimalist drip-pans. The central stem is made of brass and has spherical protrudings, especially at the receiver bowl and the bottom finial.



The Transitional **Encased Chandeliers**

The major number of chandelier gracing The Oberoi Grand are the transitional caged or encased chandeliers. Minimalist and modern, these chandeliers are a mixture of old-school and new-school. Existing in a variety of forms—'drum' chandeliers, 'caged' single-tiered chandeliers, or multi-tiered chandeliers with simple geometrical/floral prisms—these chandeliers are executed at a more petite scale. Their streamlined and sleek forms serve as testaments to the retro yet modern décor of the ever-changing face of the Grand Dame of Chowringhee.
